MASSILLON'S PAUL BROWN TIGER STADIUM**

Division V - Friday, December 2, 2011, 11:00 a.m.

Kirtland

West on I-90 toward Cleveland to I-271 S. (Exit 188). Merge onto I-77 South (Exit 10). Remain on I-77 S. to S.R. 21 (Exit 136) toward Massillon. Travel south on S.R. 21 to Cherry Ave. Turn left (east) onto Cherry for two blocks to Erie Street N.W. (1st traffic light). Turn right (south) onto Erie St. and continue to Lincoln Way East (3rd traffic light). Turn left (east) onto Lincoln Way/S.R. 172 to Hess Blvd. (7th traffic light). Turn right onto Hess Blvd. to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium.
Estimated distance is 73 miles with a driving time of 1 hour and 25 minutes.

Note: After the game, when leaving Massillon, use Hess Ave., Lincoln Way/Rt. 172 West back to Erie St. N., Cherry Ave. and S.R. 21 North.

and

Coldwater

North on S.R. 118 to S.R. 29. East on Rt. 29 to U.S. Rt. 33. East on U.S. Rt. 33 to I-75. North on I-75 to U.S. Rt. 30 (Exit 135). Remain on U.S. Rt. 30 East to Richville Drive. At bottom of ramp turn left (north) onto Richville Dr. S.W. and follow Richville Dr. to Walnut Ave. (1st traffic light), continue straight on Walnut Ave. to 16th St. S.E (1st traffic light), turn right onto 16th St. and travel over railroad tracks to Harsh Ave. (1st traffic light). Turn right onto Harsh Ave. and stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium.
Estimated distance is 195 miles with a driving time of 3 hours and 30 minutes.

Note: After the game, when leaving Massillon, use 16th St., Walnut Ave., and Richville Dr. back to U.S. Rt. 30 West.

Division III - Friday, December 2, 2011, 3:00 p.m.

Youngstown Cardinal Mooney

North on I-680 North to I-80 West. I-80 West becomes I-76 West toward Akron. Merge onto I-77 South, Exit 23A toward Canton. Remain on I-77 S. to Fulton Road N.W. (S.R. 687) (Exit 107A.) Cross over Fulton Rd. and continue south on Blake Ave. N.W to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs. **Estimated distance is 63 miles with a driving time of 1 hour and 10 minutes.**

Note: After the game, when leaving Canton, if parked near the stadium, use Blake Ave. (north) to Fulton Road (S.R. 687) and right to the I-77 northbound on-ramp **or** west on 17th St. and south on Broad Ave. to 13th St. and I-77.

and

Springfield Shawnee

East on I-70 toward Columbus to I-270 N. (Exit 93B) toward Cleveland. Merge onto I-71 N. (Exit 26) toward Cleveland. Remain on I-71 North to U.S. Rt. 30 East (Exit 176) toward Wooster. Remain on U.S. Rt. 30 East to I-77 North. North on I-77 to Exit 106 (13th St. N.W.). Turn left (west) onto 13th St. at bottom of ramp. Remain on 13th St. to Broad Ave. N.W. (2nd traffic light), right on Broad Ave. to 17th Street N.W. Turn right on 17th Street to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to the stadium. **Estimated distance is 176 miles with a driving time of 3 hours.**

Note: After the game, when leaving Canton, use 17th St., Broad Ave., and 13th St. back to I-77 South and U.S. Rt. 30 West **or** Blake Ave. (north) to Fulton Rd. N.W. (S.R. 687), and right to I-77 southbound on-ramp.

Division II - Friday, December 2, 2011, 7:00 p.m.

Avon

Southwest on Detroit Road (S.R.254) to I-90 West. Merge onto I-90 West(S.R. 2) to S.R. 57 (Exit 145A). South on S.R. 57 to I-80 East. I-80 East to I-77 South. Remain on I-77 South to S.R 21 (Exit 136). Travel south on S.R. 21 to Cherry Ave. Turn left (east) onto Cherry for two blocks to Erie Street N.W. (1st traffic light). Turn right (south) onto Erie St. and continue to Lincoln Way East (3rd traffic light). Turn left (east) onto Lincoln Way/S.R. 172 to Hess Blvd. (7th traffic light). Turn right onto Hess Blvd. to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium. **Estimated distance is 76 miles with a driving time of 1 hour and 30 minutes.**

Note: After the game, when leaving Massillon, use Hess Ave., Lincoln Way/Rt. 172 West back to Erie St. N., Cherry Ave. and S.R. 21 North.

Trotwood-Madison

North on S. Broadway Ave. and N. Union Road to Salem Ave. North on Salem Ave. (S.R. 49) to Hoke Road. North on Hoke Road to I-70. East on I-70 toward Columbus. Merge onto I-270 (Exit 93B) toward Cleveland. Remain on I-270 to I-71 (Exit 26). North on I-71 to Exit 176 (U.S. Rt. 30). Travel east on U.S. Rt. 30 to the Richville Drive Exit. At bottom of ramp turn left (north) onto Richville Dr. S.W. and follow Richville Dr. to Walnut Ave. (1st traffic light), continue straight on Walnut Ave. to 16th St. S.E (1st traffic light), turn right onto 16th St. and travel over railroad tracks to Harsh Ave. (1st traffic light). Turn right onto Harsh Ave. and stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium. **Estimated distance is 200 miles with a driving time of 3 hours and 30 minutes.**

Note: After the game, when leaving Massillon, use 16th St., Walnut Ave., and Richville Dr. back to U.S. Rt. 30 West.

Division VI - Saturday, December 3, 2011, 11:00 a.m.

New Washington Buckeye Central

South on S. Kibler Street (S.R. 602) to U.S. Rt. 30. East on Rt. 30 toward Mansfield. Remain on U.S. Rt. 30 to I-77 North toward Akron. North on I-77 to Exit 106 (13th St. N.W.). Turn left (west) onto 13th St. at bottom of ramp. Remain on 13th St. to Broad Ave. N.W. (2nd traffic light), right on Broad Ave. to 17th Street N.W. Turn right on 17th Street to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to the stadium. **Estimated distance is 97 miles with a driving time of 1 hour and 45 minutes.**

Note: After the game, when leaving Canton, use Blake Ave. (north) to Fulton Rd. N.W. (S.R. 687), and right to the southbound I-77 on-ramp **or** 17th St., Broad Ave., and 13th St. back to I-77 South and U.S. Rt. 30 West.

and

Maria Stein Marion Local

Route 119 East to Route 66, North on Rt. 66 to Route 29, East on Rt. 29 to I-75, North on I-75 to U.S. Route 30. Remain on U.S. Rt. 30 East to I-77 North. North on I-77 to Exit 107A (Fulton Rd. N.W.)(S.R. 687). Turn left (west) onto Fulton Rd. at bottom of ramp. Remain on Fulton Rd. to Blake Ave. N.W. (1st traffic signal). Turn left onto Blake Ave. and travel south to parking lot areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to the stadium. **Estimated distance is 201 miles with a driving time of 3 hours and 30 minutes.**

or

North on S.R. 716 to S.R. 274. East on S.R. 274 to I-75. North on I-75 to U.S. Route 30. East on Rt. 30 to I-77 North. North on I-77 to Exit 107A (Fulton Rd. N.W.)(S.R. 687). Turn left (west) onto Fulton Rd. at bottom of ramp. Remain on Fulton Rd. to Blake Ave. N.W. (1st traffic signal). Turn left onto Blake Ave. and travel south to parking lot areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to the stadium. **Estimated distance is 201 miles with a driving time of 3 hours and 30 minutes.**

Note: After the game, when leaving Canton, use 17th St., Broad Ave., and 13th St. back to I-77 South and U.S. Rt. 30 West **or** Blake Ave. (north) to Fulton Rd. N.W. (S.R. 687), and right to the southbound I-77 on-ramp.

Division IV - Saturday, December 3, 2011, 3:00 p.m.

Creston Norwayne

North on S.R. 3 to I-76. East on I-76 to S.R. 21. South on S.R. 21 toward Massillon to Cherry Ave. Turn left (east) onto Cherry for two blocks to Erie Street N.W. (1st traffic light). Turn right (south) onto Erie St. and continue to Lincoln Way East (3rd traffic light). Turn left (east) onto Lincoln Way/S.R. 172 to Hess Blvd. (7th traffic light). Turn right onto Hess Blvd. to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium.

or

South on Cleveland Road (S. R. 3) to Easton Road (S.R. 604). East on Easton Rd. to Akron Road 9S.R. 585). North on S.R. 585 to S.R. 21. South on S.R. 21 toward Massillon to Cherry Ave. Turn left (east) onto Cherry for two blocks to Erie Street N.W. (1st traffic light). Turn right (south) onto Erie St. and continue to Lincoln Way East (3rd traffic light). Turn left (east) onto Lincoln Way/S.R. 172 to Hess Blvd. (7th traffic light). Turn right onto Hess Blvd. to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium.

Estimated distance is 35 miles with a driving time of 45 minutes.

Note: After the game, when leaving Massillon, use Hess Ave., Lincoln Way/Rt. 172 West back to Erie St. N., Cherry Ave. and S.R. 21 North.

Northeast on E. Columbus St.(S.R.67) to S.R 294. East on S.R. 294 to S.R. 128. North on S.R. 128 to U.S. Rt. 30. East on U.S. Rt. 30 to Richville Drive. At bottom of ramp turn left (north) onto Richville Dr. S.W. and follow Richville Dr. to Walnut Ave. (1st traffic light), continue straight on Walnut Ave. to 16th St. S.E (1st traffic light), turn right onto 16th St. and travel over railroad tracks to Harsh Ave. (1st traffic light). Turn right onto Harsh Ave. and stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium. **Estimated distance is 125 miles with a driving time of 2 hours and 25 minutes.**

Note: After the game, when leaving Massillon, use 16th St., Walnut Ave., and Richville Dr. back to U.S. Rt. 30 West.

Division I - Saturday, December 3, 2011, 7:00 p.m.

Cleveland St. Ignatius

South on U.S. Rt. 42 to I-490, east on I-490 to I-77, south on I-77 to Exit 107A, Fulton Rd. (S.R. 687). Cross over Fulton Rd. and continue south on Blake Ave. N.W to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs. **Estimated distance is 60 miles with a driving time of 1 hour and 5 minutes.**

However, please note that due to the large anticipated crowd coming from the north for this game, the State Highway Patrol will be closing southbound Exit 107A (Fulton Road N.W.) periodically starting two (2) hours before game time in order to eliminate potential backup on I-77. If arriving during the closed period, please continue south to either Exit 106, (13th Street N.W.) If exiting at Exit 106 (13th Street), turn right at the traffic light (13th Street) and travel west on 13th St. to 1st traffic signal (Broad Ave. N.W.). Turn right onto Broad Ave. to 17th St N.W., turn right onto 17th St. N.W. to the stadium parking lot areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs.

Note: After the game, when leaving Canton, if parked near the stadium, use Blake Ave. (north) to Fulton Road (S.R. 687) and right to the I-77 northbound on-ramp or west on 17th St. and south on Broad Ave. to 13th St. and I-77.

Pickerington Central

North on Hill Road N. (S.R. 256) to I-70 East toward Wheeling W.V. Remain on I-70 East to I-77 North (Exit 180B) toward Cleveland. Remain on I-77 N. To 13th St. N.W. (Exit 106). Turn left (west) onto 13th St. at bottom of ramp. Remain on 13th St. to Broad Ave. N.W. (2nd traffic light), right on Broad Ave. to 17th Street N.W. Turn right on 17th Street to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to the stadium. **Estimated distance is 135 miles with a driving time of 2 hours and 15 minutes.**

Also, please note that due to the large anticipated crowd coming from the north for this game, the State Highway Patrol will be closing southbound Exit 107A (Fulton Road N.W.) periodically starting two (2) hours before game time in order to eliminate potential backup on I-77. If arriving during the closed period, please continue south to Exit 106, (13th Street N.W.). If exiting at Exit 106 (13th Street), turn right at the traffic light (13th Street) and travel west on 13th St. to 1st traffic signal (Broad Ave. N.W.). Turn right onto Broad Ave. to 17th St N.W., turn right onto 17th St. N.W. to the stadium parking lot areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs.
