**Division III - Friday, November 4, 2009, 11:00 a.m.**

**Youngstown Cardinal Mooney**

North on I-680 North to I-80 West. I-80 West becomes I-76 West toward Akron. Merge onto I-77 South, Exit 23A toward Canton. Remain on I-77 S. to Exit 104, U.S. Rt. 30 (Massillon), west on U.S. Rt. 30 to Richville Drive Exit. At bottom of ramp turn right (north) onto Richville Dr. S.W., follow Richville Dr. to Walnut Ave. (1<sup>st</sup> traffic light), continue straight on Walnut Ave. to 16<sup>th</sup> St. S.E 1<sup>st</sup> traffic light), turn right onto 16<sup>th</sup> St. and travel over railroad tracks to Harsh Ave. (1<sup>st</sup> traffic light). Turn right onto Harsh Ave. and stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium.

**Note:** After the game, when leaving Massillon, use 16<sup>th</sup> St., Walnut Ave., and Richville Dr. back to U.S. Rt. 30 east and I-77 North.

**Columbus St. Francis DeSales**

West on Morse Road to I-71 North. Remain on I-71 North to Exit 176 (U.S. Rt. 30). Travel east on U.S. Rt. 30 to the Rt. 172 Exit (Lincoln Way), east on Lincoln Way/S.R. 172 to Hess Blvd. Turn right onto Hess Blvd. to stadium parking areas. Follow the signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium.

**Note:** After the game, when leaving Massillon, use Hess Ave., Lincoln Way/Rt. 172 West back to U.S. 30 West.

**Division V - Friday, December 4, 2009, 3:00 p.m.**

**Youngstown Ursuline**

North on I-680 North to I-80 West. I-80 West becomes I-76 West. West on I-76 to Exit 48, S.R. 225. South on S.R. 225 to U.S. 224. West on U.S. 224 to S.R. 225. South on S.R. 225 to U.S. Rt. 62 West. Remain on Rt. 62 West to Fulton Rd. (S.R. 687) Exit. Cross over Fulton Rd. and continue south on Blake Ave. N.W to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to the stadium parking areas.

**or**

North on I-680 North to I-80 West. I-80 West becomes I-76 West toward Akron. Merge onto I-77 South, Exit 23A. Remain on I-77 S. to Exit 107A, Fulton Rd. (S.R. 687). Cross over Fulton Rd. and continue south on Blake Ave. N.W to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to the stadium parking areas.

**Note:** After the game, when leaving Canton, use Blake Ave. (north) to Fulton Rd. N.W. (S.R. 687), and right to Rt. 62 East and/or I-77 North on-ramps **or** 17<sup>th</sup> St., Broad Ave., and 13<sup>th</sup> St. to I-77 North and Rt. 62 East.

**Coldwater**

East on S.R. 219 to U.S. Rt. 127. North on S.R. 127 to S.R. 129. East on S.R. 129, which becomes U.S. Rt. 33, to I-75 North. North on I-75 to U.S. Rt. 30, Exit 135. East on Rt. 30 to I-77. North on I-77 to Exit 106 (13<sup>th</sup> St. N.W.). Turn left (west) onto 13<sup>th</sup> St. at bottom of ramp. Remain on 13<sup>th</sup> St. to Broad Ave. N.W. (2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light), right on Broad Ave. to 17<sup>th</sup> Street N.W. Turn right on 17<sup>th</sup> Street to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to the stadium.

**Note:** After the game, when leaving Canton, use 17<sup>th</sup> St., Broad Ave., and 13<sup>th</sup> St. back to I-77 South and U.S. Rt. 30 West **or** Blake Ave. (north) to Fulton Rd. N.W. (S.R. 687), and right to I-77 southbound on-ramp.

**Division II - Friday, December 4, 2009, 7:00 p.m.**

**Maple Heights**

East on I-480 to I-271 South, south on I-271 to OH Rt. 8 South (Exit 18) toward Akron. OH Rt. 8 South becomes I-77 South. Remain on I-77 S. to Exit 104, U.S. Rt. 30 (Massillon), west on U.S. Rt. 30 to Richville Drive Exit. At bottom of ramp turn right (north) onto Richville Dr. S.W., follow Richville Dr. to Walnut Ave. (1<sup>st</sup> traffic light), continue straight on Walnut Ave. to 16<sup>th</sup> St. S.E. 1<sup>st</sup> traffic light), turn right onto 16<sup>th</sup> St. and travel over railroad tracks to Harsh Ave. (1<sup>st</sup> traffic light). Turn right onto Harsh Ave. and stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium.

**Note:** After the game, when leaving Massillon, use 16<sup>th</sup> St., Walnut Ave., and Richville Dr. back to U.S. Rt. 30 east and I-77 North.

**Cincinnati Winton Woods**

East on I-275 East to I-71 North, Exit 49 toward Columbus. Remain on I-71 North from Columbus to Exit 176 (U.S. Rt. 30). Travel east on U.S. Rt. 30 to the Rt. 172 Exit (Lincoln Way), east on Lincoln Way/S.R. 172 to Hess Blvd. Turn right onto Hess Blvd. to stadium parking areas. Follow the signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium.

**Note:** After the game, when leaving Massillon, use Hess Ave., Lincoln Way/Rt. 172 West back to U.S. 30 West.

**Division IV - Saturday, December 5, 2009, 11:00 a.m.**

**Chagrin Falls**

West on Miles Road to I-271 South, south on I-271 to OH Rt. 8 South (Exit 18) toward Akron. OH Rt. 8 South becomes I-77 South. Remain on I-77 S. to Exit 107A, Fulton Rd. (S.R. 687). Cross over Fulton Rd. and continue south on Blake Ave. N.W to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to the stadium parking areas.

**Note:** After the game, when leaving Canton, use Blake Ave. (north) to Fulton Rd. N.W. (S.R. 687), and right to I-77 northbound on-ramp **or** 17<sup>th</sup> St., Broad Ave., and 13<sup>th</sup> St. back to I-77 North.

**Kettering Archbishop Alter**

North on I-71 to Exit 176 U.S. Rt. 30, east on Rt. 30 to I-77, north on I-77 to Exit 106 (13<sup>th</sup> St. N.W.). Turn left (west) onto 13<sup>th</sup> St. at bottom of ramp to Broad Ave. N.W. (2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light), right onto Broad Ave. to 17<sup>th</sup> Street N.W., right on 17<sup>th</sup> St. to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to the stadium.

**Note:** After the game, when leaving Canton, use 17<sup>th</sup> St., Broad Ave., and 13<sup>th</sup> St. back to I-77 South and U.S. Rt. 30 West **or** Blake Ave. (north) to Fulton Rd. N.W. (S.R. 687), and right to I-77 southbound on-ramp.

**Division VI - Saturday, December 5, 2009, 3:00 p.m.**

**Norwalk St. Paul**

South on U.S. 250 to U.S. 224 toward Akron. East on U.S. 224 to I-76. East on I-76 to S.R. 21. Travel south on S.R. 21 toward Massillon to Cherry Ave. Turn left (east) onto Cherry for two blocks to Erie Street N.W. (1<sup>st</sup> traffic light). Turn right (south) onto Erie St. and continue to Lincoln Way East (3<sup>rd</sup> traffic light). Turn left (east) onto Lincoln Way/S.R. 172 to Hess Blvd. (7<sup>th</sup> traffic light). Turn right onto Hess Blvd. to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium.

**Note:** After the game, when leaving Massillon, use Hess Ave., Lincoln Way/Rt. 172 West back to Erie St. N., Cherry Ave. and S.R. 21 North.

**and**

**Delphos St. John's**

Travel east on U.S. Rt. 30 to the Richville Drive Exit. At bottom of ramp turn left (north) onto Richville Dr. S.W. and follow Richville Dr. to Walnut Ave. (1<sup>st</sup> traffic light), continue straight on Walnut Ave. to 16<sup>th</sup> St. S.E (1<sup>st</sup> traffic light), turn right onto 16<sup>th</sup> St. and travel over railroad tracks to Harsh Ave. (1<sup>st</sup> traffic light). Turn right onto Harsh Ave. and stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to Paul Brown Tiger Stadium.

**Note:** After the game, when leaving Massillon, use 16<sup>th</sup> St., Walnut Ave., and Richville Dr. back to U.S. Rt. 30 West.

**Division I - Saturday, December 5, 2009, 7:00 p.m.**

**Cleveland Glenville**

West on I-90 to I-77 South, exit 172A toward Akron. Remain on I-77 South to exit 107A, Fulton Rd. (S.R. 687). Cross over Fulton Rd. and continue south on Blake Ave. N.W to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs.

**However, please note that due to the large anticipated crowd coming from the north for this game, the State Highway Patrol will be closing southbound Exit 107A (Fulton Road N.W.) periodically starting two (2) hours before game time in order to eliminate potential backup on I-77. If arriving during the closed period, please continue south to either Exit 106, (13<sup>th</sup> Street N.W.) or Exit 105 (Tuscarawas Street/Downtown). If exiting at Exit 106 (13<sup>th</sup> Street), turn right at the traffic light (13<sup>th</sup> Street) and travel west on 13<sup>th</sup> St. to 1<sup>st</sup> traffic signal (Broad Ave. N.W.). Turn right onto Broad Ave. to 17<sup>th</sup> St N.W., turn right onto 17<sup>th</sup> St. N.W. to the stadium parking lot areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs.**

**For bus shuttle service to and from the stadium, exit at Exit 105 (S.R. 172/Tuscarawas Street/Downtown). Off site parking and free bus shuttle service will be provided for this game at a cost of \$3.00 per vehicle. Follow the green and white OHSAA shuttle signs to the designated parking area. Also, please note that parking will be limited to approximately 400 vehicles.**

**Note:** After the game, when leaving Canton, if parked near the stadium, use Blake Ave. (north) to Fulton Road (S.R. 687) and right to the I-77 northbound on-ramp or west on 17<sup>th</sup> St. and south on Broad Ave. to 13<sup>th</sup> St. and I-77. If parked near Exit 105, use the adjacent on-ramps to I-77 North.

**Division I - Saturday, December 5, 2009, 7:00 p.m.**

**Hilliard Davidson**

East on I-270 East to I-71 North, Exit 26 toward Cleveland. Remain on I-71 North to Exit 176 (U.S. Rt. 30), east on Rt. 30 to I-77, north on I-77 to Exit 106, (13<sup>th</sup> St. N.W.). Turn left (west) at bottom of ramp onto 13<sup>th</sup> St. and travel west to 2<sup>nd</sup> traffic light, (Broad Ave. N.W.). Turn right (north) onto Broad Ave. to 17<sup>th</sup> St. N.W.. Turn right onto 17<sup>th</sup> St. to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to the stadium.

If arriving from the north or the Belden Village area, travel south on I-77 to Exit 107A, Fulton Rd. N.W. (S.R. 687). Cross over Fulton Rd. and then continue straight south on Blake Ave. N.W. to stadium parking areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs to the stadium.

**However, please note that due to the large anticipated crowd coming from the north for this game, the State Highway Patrol will be closing southbound Exit 107A (Fulton Road N.W.) periodically starting two (2) hours before game time in order to eliminate potential backup on I-77. If arriving during the closed period, please continue south to either Exit 106, (13<sup>th</sup> Street N.W.) or Exit 105 (Tuscarawas Street/Downtown). If exiting at Exit 106 (13<sup>th</sup> Street), turn right at the traffic light (13<sup>th</sup> Street) and travel west on 13<sup>th</sup> St. to 1<sup>st</sup> traffic signal (Broad Ave. N.W.). Turn right onto Broad Ave. to 17<sup>th</sup> St N.W., turn right onto 17<sup>th</sup> St. N.W. to the stadium parking lot areas. Follow the blue and white OHSAA signs.**

**For bus shuttle service to and from the stadium, exit at Exit 105 (S.R. 172/Tuscarawas Street/Downtown). Off site parking and free bus shuttle service will be provided for this game at a cost of \$3.00 per vehicle. Follow the green and white OHSAA shuttle signs to the designated parking area. Also, please note, that parking will be limited to approximately 400 vehicles.**

**Note:** After the game when leaving Canton, if parked near the stadium, use Blake Ave. (north) to Fulton Road (S.R. 687) and right to I-77 on-ramps or west on 17<sup>th</sup> St. and south on Broad Ave. to 13<sup>th</sup> St. and the I-77 on-ramps. If parked near Exit 105, use the adjacent on-ramps to I-77.
